

I would like to introduce myself to the group, as I am new to Intellenet. I am an expert in fire origin & cause investigation, scene analysis & reconstruction. My formal education includes a B.S. degree in Business Administration from the University of Southern California (USC). In addition, I completed post graduate work at the National Fire Academy in the Executive Fire Officer (EFO) Program. I hold certifications as a Chief Fire Officer (CFO) with The Center for Public Safety Excellence (CPSE) as well as Chief Officer & Executive Chief Fire Officer through the California State Fire Marshal. I have attended numerous initial, advanced & continuing education courses & seminars in various aspects of fire investigation.

I am currently the Fire Marshal for the Carpinteria-Summerland Fire Protection District (CA), where I supervise the Fire/Arson Investigation Unit. I have over 29 years of experience in the fire service, 22 years as a Fire Investigator & have investigated more than 2,500 fires. I was previously a Task Force Officer with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives (BATFE) & am currently a California State Fire Marshal instructor for beginning & advanced arson courses. Moreover, I am a Certified Fire Investigator (CFI) through the International Association of Arson Investigators (IAAI), California Conference of Arson Investigators (CCAI) & a Certified Fire & Explosion Investigator (CFEI) through the National Association of Fire Investigators (NAFI).

I am experienced in the insurance investigation field working as a Fire Investigator. I often work for various fire agencies, as well as attorneys as a consultant on complex fire/arson cases. I have testified numerous times in both criminal & civil courts as an expert witness. In addition, I am a frequent lecturer in fire investigation techniques at various training conferences for the IAAI, CCAI & International Association of Fire Chiefs (IAFC). I look forward to working with many of you in the future.





DISCLOSE OR NOT TO DISCLOSE-EXPERTS CAN PLAY A DUAL ROLE

When or if to disclose an expert has been an age-old conundrum for attorneys. Should counsel retain a forensic expert who is a <u>testifying</u> expert whose work product is <u>discoverable</u> or retain an expert as a <u>consultant</u> who is <u>exempt</u> from discovery? Can attorneys & your clients have the best of both worlds? Yes. There <u>is</u> a simple solution.

Forensic Experts in my area of expertise, Questioned Document Examiners & Handwriting Identification Analysts, are retained as impartial, disinterested neutral parties & do not have a 'client.' Their fiduciary is to the justice system regardless of who retains their services. Most list themselves as 'testifying experts' not 'consultants.' If retained as 'testifying experts,' their cases are vulnerable, due to their potential <u>adverse</u> opinion. It happens.

Since <u>consulting</u> experts are exempt from deposition under the Fed.R.Civ.Pro.26 (b) (4) (D), retaining parties can glean from & share valuable information with their forensic consultants free from fear of discovery. All work product is protected.

The role of the <u>consultant</u> is that of advisor specifically retained to assist the attorney in preparation for trial or deposition. A forensic consultant is free to advise the attorney as to the complex scientific, investigative & multi-faceted aspects of their case. With years of empirical knowledge, a consultant can assist in preparing questions for cross or direct examination & provide invaluable guidance & education. A consultant can clarify issues by viewing the case from the granular level to a '30,000' foot approach, in its entirety, while maintaining complete confidentiality.

An engagement agreement stipulating to 'consultation only' eliminates the possibility of an adverse opinion becoming discoverable. The retaining party does not disclose the consultant without the expert's written permission. All conversations, emails, text messages, phone calls, notes & reports are work product & protected. Should the consultant agree to testify & be named as an expert, a separate engagement agreement to transition would be drafted.

For example; suppose in an attorney's limitless enthusiasm, confident in the merits of his or her case, or due to a short deadline to disclose experts, they immediately add their expert (sometimes without actually retaining them, which is not legal) to their witness list without knowing the outcome of the investigation. Suppose after naming their expert, the expert's opinion is contrary, adverse to the anticipated outcome?

Several years ago, I encountered this exact situation. I received a phone call prior in regard to a huge, multi-million dollar contested Will case in Palm Beach. Pursuant to the rules of engagement I must adhere to as an expert, the documents must be submitted, along with our engagement agreement & retainer. We must be legally retained to avoid possible conflicts of interest. This did not happen. The attorney did not notify me or submit the documents prior to naming me as his expert. I was served a subpoena the same day I received & examined the suspect documents. Contrary to counsel's belief, the document in question was not authentic. Neither the ink, nor paper was the correct vintage. The signature was traced. The retaining party was absolutely certain his client had provided an authentic document. It was devastating to the retaining party's case when I was deposed.

To avoid this unfortunate situation from recurring, I modified my engagement agreement to read, 'Engagement Agreement for Forensic Consultation.' Depending on the outcome, an expert can transition from consultant to a testifying expert. However, not all forensic consultants will. Some do not testify under any circumstances. When retaining an expert as a <u>testifying</u> witness, all conversations, notes, emails, texts & reports are subject to discovery & subpoena. As such, an attorney is limited when discussing facts & hypotheses with a testifying witness. No 'brain-storming.' The expert will likely be deposed unless the case settles. The role of a testifying expert is to address the facts & issues <u>after</u> the case has been constructed. That being said, the choice of retaining a consultant versus retaining a testifying expert should be decided upon, on a per case basis. If a transition from forensic consultant to testifying expert is requested, the transition is a simple process. The retaining party & expert would sign an engagement agreement to transition the consultant to a testifying expert.

Intellenet Scholarship Award

Established in 2017 and annually thereafter Intellenet plans to award at least two scholarships to a child, step child, grand child or grand step child of an Active Member in good standing of Intellenet. The scholarships are intended to provide financial assistance to students entering their first year of college, a post graduate year, vocational/trade school or students presently attending a college or university. A scholarship will be awarded to one child of an active Intellenet member's family. The recipient or recipients will be chosen by the Scholarship Committee, selected by the Intellenet Executive Director, and their decision will be final. Previous Intellenet scholarship award recipients are not eligible to apply. Only those who plan to be enrolled the ensuing fall semester are eligible to apply. It is the expectation of Intellenet that the applicant be in good standing with their present academic institution.

Criteria

All applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements: Be child, step child, grand child or grand step child of an Active Member in good standing of Intellenet, and one of the following: A high school senior who will be continuing their education at an undergraduate college or university, junior college, vocational or technical college. A high school senior who will be continuing their education in a post graduate year. A post-secondary student attending an undergraduate college or university, junior college, vocational or technical college.

Application Procedure

The application is on the following page and can be submitted electronically to the Scholarship Committee by emailing intellenet@intellenet.org. Applications must be submitted no later than <u>February 22, 2022</u> at 5:00 PM EST. The scholarship recipients will be announced at the yearly Intellenet Conference gala banquet. Recipients of the scholarship will be required to provide proof of enrollment at an eligible post-secondary institution prior to the funds being dispersed.
